PUBLIC NOTICE

WARNING AGAINST PROCUREMENT SCAMMERS!

The Namibia Qualifications Authority (NQA) wishes to alert all prospective bidders, service providers, and members of the public to reports of individuals fraudulently impersonating officials from its Procurement Management Unit (PMU). These individuals are allegedly soliciting payments, gifts, or other inducements in exchange for the awarding of procurement contracts, using unofficial communication channels such as personal email addresses, social media platforms, and private mobile phone numbers.

The NQA categorically states that these activities are fraudulent and do not represent the practices or procedures of the Authority.

Members of the public, bidders, and service providers are hereby informed that:

1. All NQA procurement processes are conducted strictly in accordance with the Public Procurement Act and applicable regulations.
2. No NQA employee, official, or representative is authorised to request or accept any form of payment, gift, commission, or favour in exchange for the award of a bid or contract.
3. The NQA does not conduct procurement activities through social media, personal email addresses, or private mobile phones.
4. All procurement communications are conducted through official NQA channels only.
5. Any person who receives suspicious calls, messages, or requests claiming to be from NQA officials should not make any payments or commitments and should immediately report the matter to the relevant authorities.

The NQA urges all stakeholders to remain vigilant and to verify any procurement related communication through official NQA channels. Any suspicious incidents should be reported immediately to:
